Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 141 dated 01.11.2017, under Sections 186, 353, 332 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No. 2, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is alleged that the petitioners had given iron rod blows on the complainant and had snatched a bag containing ₹5,940/-. He, however, contends that the injuries were found to be simple in nature and the matter has been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the compromise at Annexure P2. He also contends that a petition for quashing the FIR has been filed by the petitioners in which notice of motion has been issued.

This Court, by the order dated 24.09.2021, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 24.09.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
