1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the instant contempt petition was filed on account of the intentional and willful disobedience of undertaking on the basis of which order (Annexure P-1) dated 29.09.2020 in CWP No.11585 of 2020, was passed, directing provisional release of the goods in terms of orders passed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in SLP (C) No.17307 of 2019 as well as terms and conditions enumerated in Annexure P-28 appended to the writ petition but now, goods of the petitioner have been released in terms of order dated 29.09.2020, therefore, the petitioner does not wish to prosecute the contempt petition any further and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

3. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn.***
