Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in DDR No.25 dated 25.03.2021 under Sections 324, 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda, in FIR No.44 dated 25.03.2021 under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149, 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per MLR of the complainant/victim, he has suffered three injuries and injury No.2 is declared grievous, which is caused by way of sharp-edged weapon on left forearm of the complainant, whereas other injuries are simple in nature. It is further submitted that injury No.2 is attributed to co-accused Kuldeep Singh. It is also submitted

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that it is a case of version and cross-version and he has instructions to say that without prejudice to their right of defence, the petitioners are ready to pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- to the victim/complainant towards medical expenses.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State while Mr. G.S. Saini, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the complainant.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the fact that grievous injury is attributed to co-accused Kuldeep Singh and the petitioners have volunteered to pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- to the victim, without prejudice to their right of defence, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are granted the concession of anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioners will hand over the amount of Rs.10,000/- to the Investigating Officer within a period of 15 days from today and the said amount will further be handed over to victim Gurjant Singh, against a proper receipt.
