1. This petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No.04, dated 20.01.2020, under Sections 302 read with Section 34 IPC, 1860 to which Section 457, 380, 411 and 201 have been added later on, registered at Police Station Thulliwal, District Barnala.

2. One of the main ground for seeking regular bail is the custody period and trial is not proceeding at an appropriate pace.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh submits that prosecution evidence is complete. The next date in trial is 17th November, 2021 for defence evidence.

4. Considering the statement made by the learned State counsel now the ball lies in the court of the accused.

5. The petition for regular bail is disposed of at this stage. However, there is no doubt in case a request is made before the court concerned for early conclusion of the trial with the co-operation of the parties, the same would be dealt in accordance with law.
