Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioner No.2 is the son of petitioner No.1. The petitioners had given shelter to respondent No.4 when she was thrown out of her house by her husband. The husband of respondent No.4 along with others had beaten up respondent No.4 and she had lodged a complaint against her husband. However, later the petitioners learnt that she has filed a complaint against petitioner No.2 levelling allegations of rape. He further contends that the allegations are false and action be taken against respondent No.4. The petitioners have sent a representation dated 16.09.2021 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala in this regard but no action has been taken thereon.

Heard.

It is apparent from a bare reading of the petition that respondent

No.4 has lodged a complaint against petitioner No.2 levelling serious allegations. It is not possible for this Court at this juncture to arrive at a conclusion that the complaint preferred by respondent No.4 is false or frivolous. The allegations against respondent No.4 in this petition appear to be unsubstantiated. Therefore, I do not find any merit in this petition which stands dismissed.

However, it is clarified that nothing which has been observed hereinabove shall be deemed to have any bearing on the merits of the case.
