GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.221 dated 25.08.2021 at Police Station Khol, District Rewari, under Sections 323/506/377/34 IPC.
2. The FIR was lodged at the instance of Pardeep, wherein it is alleged that he works as a labourer and that on 25.08.2021 at about 7 AM, when he went to the fields of Kalia for sowing vegetables, Thawar Singh @ Sittu took him on his motor-cycle to the tubewell of Satish, where Satish and Thawar Singh removed his clothes and gave beatings to him and poured petrol on his private parts on account of which he was in agony.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter has since been compromised amongst the parties and the differences have been resolved and that the complainant does not have any objection for grant of bail.
4. At this stage, Mr. Baljeet Beniwal, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of complainant/respondent No.2 and has endorsed the factum of compromise and has stated that he has no objection for grant of bail to the petitioner.
5. Learned State counsel has, however, opposed the petition on the ground that there is ample evidence to establish the allegations leveled against the accused and that in fact there is a video recording as well.
6. I have considered rival submissions addressed before this Court.
7. Having regard to the fact that the matter is stated to have been amicably resolved amongst the parties and the complainant has categorically stated before this Court that he has no objection for grant of bail, the instant petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
