This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the pension along with arrears and interest on the delayed pension of the petitioner, who retired on 30.6.2020 as Safai Karamchari. It is further prayed that the respondent No.2 be directed to decide the legal notice Annexure P-4, issued by the petitioner by a well reasoned speaking order and if found favour, the amount be released to him within a reasonable period.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents decide the claim of the petitioner within a time frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and Mr. Padamkant Dwivedi, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.2 to 5.. Even counsel for the respondents are not

averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the claim of the petitioner by taking a conscious decision and by passing a speaking order; within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioner is found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioner within a further period of one month; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
