Present petition has been filed seeking direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to take appropriate action on the representation of the petitioner dated 16.08.2021 (Annexure P-1) wherein, certain allegations have been levelled against respondent Nos.4 to 6 with regard to mis-appropriation of the amount, which was taken from the petitioner on the pretext of sending the petitioner abroad.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Akashdeep Singh, APP, U.T., who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab-respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 3 submits that the aforesaid representation of the petitioner is already under consideration and inquiry is being conducted with regard to the allegations and therefore, the

grievance being raised by the petitioner that no action is being taken on the representation dated 16.08.2021 (Annexure P-1), is totally incorrect.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 3 further submits that as difficulties are being faced in order to unearth the truth behind the allegations, the inquiry is taking time to conclude. Learned counsel further submits that all the efforts are being made to conclude the inquiry as expeditiously as possible and in case after the conclusion of the same any action is required to be taken, the same shall be taken expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the submission of learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 3, he does not press this petition any more and the same may be disposed of as such.
