SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Since the learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab submits that, after completion of investigation into the FIR bearing No. 0014 dated 14.1.2021, registered at Police Station Division-B, District Amritsar, the investigating officer has filed a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., before the learned Magistrate concerned. Therefore, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

2. Permission granted.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. However, the learned Magistrate concerned is directed to, forthwith make an order upon the petitioner's application, cast under Section 173 (8) Cr.P.C. In case the petitioner is aggrieved, she may proceed, to take recourse to an appropriate remedy, in accordance with law. Moreover, it is also open to the petitioner to, at an appropriate stage, seek the discharge of her husband from the offences (supra), carried in the FIR (supra).
