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By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.43, dated 11.03.2021, having been registered at Police Station Jathlana, District Yamunanagar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 148/149/323/302/506 of the IPC (with Section 25 of the Arms Act deleted later).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a co-accused of the petitioner, i.e. Gulafsha, has already been admitted to bail by this court vide an order passed on 16.09.2021, in CRM-M-28297-2021, with no specific role attributed to either her or to the present petitioner, i.e. Shehnaz, who are simply alleged to have been present at the spot.

Upon query to learned State counsel he submits that, as per his instructions, the charges are still to be framed by the trial court, with the petitioner having been in custody for the past about 9 months.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail, upon her furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the

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satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

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Though two accused of the petitioner have been admitted to bail by this court, however learned State counsel submits that a specific role has been attributed to petitioner in this case, i.e. Israr alias Kali.

Adjourned to 06.01.2022.
