By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR No. 21 having been registered against him at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot, on 20.02.2020, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914.

Learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 02.11.2020 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.
