This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. has been moved by petitioners for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.125 dated 26.06.2021 under Sections 120-B and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Tibba, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 24.09.2021, they have already paid a sum of Rs.50,000/- to the complainant-Sanjeev Kumar, whereas balance amount of Rs.2 lakhs would be paid by them to complainant-Sanjeev Kumar in monthly installments of Rs.10,000/-each and no deviation in that regard would be made at any point of time. He further submits that petitioners have already joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Kulwant Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 24.09.2021, both petitioners have already joined investigation and are not required for further investigation or any kind of custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2/complainant has also given concurrence to the undertaking given on behalf of the petitioners in respect of repayment of balance amount of Rs.2 lakhs in monthly installments by the petitioners.

In view of above, order dated 24.09.2021 granting interim bail to petitioners, is made absolute. Petitioners shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
