By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.32, dated 29.12.2020, having been registered at Police Station GRP, District Sangrur, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 307/324/323/148/149 of the IPC (with Section 34 IPC added later).

The petitioner having in custody for about 11 months now with no prosecution witness stated to have been examined so far out of 23 and with learned counsel for the petitioner further pointing out that he has not even been named in the FIR, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail, upon him furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
