The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 164 dated 19.07.2021 under Sections 148, 149, 452, 323, 324, 325, 326 and 506 IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

On 24.09.2021, this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.164 dated 19.07.2021 registered under Sections 148, 149, 452, 323, 324, 325, 326 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia contends that all the petitioners are ladies and the entire family of the petitioners has been implicated in the present case. The petitioners have not been attributed any specific injury to them. Petitioner No.1 has been attributed fists blows to the sister of

the complainant and is also alleged to have given abuses. Petitioner Nos.2 and 3 have also been alleged to have given fists blows to the mother of the complainant. The alleged grievous injury is caused to the complainant and not to the sister and mother of the complainant. It is also submitted that co-accused of the petitioners, namely Krishna, has already been granted interim protection by this Court vide order dated 09.09.2021 passed in CRM-M-37266-2021 and the said case is listed for 10.11.2021.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Praveen Bhadu, AAG, Haryana, appears and accepts notice on behalf of State of Haryana and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 10.11.2021.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-37266-2021. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in pursuance of the said order, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required any further.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, moreso the fact that the petitioners are ladies; they have not been attributed any specific injury and have collectively been attributed

giving of fist blows and have also joined the investigation, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 24.09.2021 is ordered to be made absolute.

However, nothing stated above shall be construed as a final expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the trial would proceed independently of the observations made in the present case which are only for the purpose of adjudicating the present bail application.
