By filing the present contempt petition, Om Parkash-petitioner has alleged non-compliance of orders dated 30.09.2013, 01.08.2011 and 02.02.2012 Annexures P-1, P-2 and P-3, passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court in Contempt Petition Diary No.40198 of 2012, Review Petition No.2813 of 2011 in SLP (C)No.16298 of 2011 respectively.

A perusal of the aforesaid orders, annexed with the petition, reveals that no relief has been granted to the petitioner in those proceedings. All the petitions have been dismissed.

Vide order date 01.08.2011 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, SLP (C)No.16298 of 2011 titled Om Parkash Vs. M/s Ruchi Telecom, was dismissed.

Vide order dated 02.02.2012 (Annexure P-3), the Review Petition (C) No.2813 of 2011 in SLP (C) No.16298 of 2011 was dismissed.

Further, vide the order dated 30.09.2013 (Annexure P-1) the IA No.1 in CONMT. PET. (C)No.D40198/2012 in R.P.(C) No.2813/2011 filed by the

petitioner-Om Parkash was dismissed. The order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court reads:-

“... In our considered view, the petitioner has miserably failed to show any violation of orders dated 01.08.2011 and 02.02.2012 passed by this Court in SLP (C) No.2813 of 2011 respectively.

I.A. No.1 is accordingly dismissed.”

In view of above, there appears no merit in the petition.

Moreover, this Court has no jurisdiction in respect of alleged contempt of an order of Hon'ble Supreme court.

Dismissed.
