The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* to quash the action of the respondents vide which retiral benefits of the deceased-husband of the petitioner has been wrongly withheld by the respondents as well as to issue writ in the nature of *mandamus* with a direction to the respondents to release all the retiral benefits of the husband of the petitioner forthwith alongwith 18% per annum, for which, representation dated 10.05.2021

(Annexure P-4) has also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider the representation dated 10.05.2021 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released without any delay as per law.
