The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* to quash the impugned action of the respondents whereby they have declined to consider the case of the petitioner for grant of family pension on account of recovery against the deceased employee/husband of the petitioner with further prayer to issue writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant family pension to the petitioner alongwith arrears and interest @ 18% per annum, for which,

representation dated 04.07.2021 (Annexure P-4) has also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

Heard. Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let copy of the paper book be supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner side, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider the representation dated 04.07.2021 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
