The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.164, dated 14.09.2020, registered under Sections 420, 494 of IPC at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

The petitioner herein is the husband of the complainant who has approached this Court seeking anticipatory bail. During the pendency of these proceedings, the parties herein agreed to settle all disputes by filing a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act and it had been agreed that the petitioner would pay an amount of Rs.12,50,000/- as permanent alimony and maintenance, which figure would also include any *istridhan* left behind in a matrimonial home. The parties put in appearance before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and a settlement

has been arrived at between the parties which is annexed with this petition. The parties have decided to part ways. In terms of the settlement, an amount of Rs.5 lakhs has already been paid to the complainant as noticed in the settlement agreement.

Since the parties have resolved their differences before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court vide settlement agreement dated 10.09.2021, the interim order dated 02.11.2020 whereby arrest of the petitioner was made, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition is allowed accordingly.
