ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.73 dated 25.03.2021, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC read with Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of the co-accused Jagdeep. No specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner and it is alleged that he along with other accused have hurled brick bats at the injured. The injured has fully recovered from the injuries. The petitioner is in custody for about 2 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Amar Singh, contends that the matter is under investigation. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is not named in the FIR, he is in custody for about 2 months, the COVID-19

pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
