The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.07 dated 04.06.2018, under Sections 307, 34 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran, on the basis of compromise dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-2), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although it is alleged that shots were fired but no one was injured in the occurrence. It is a case of no injury. The FIR is outcome of misunderstanding and suspicion which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the compromise at Annexure P-2.

This Court, vide order dated 27.09.2021 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their statements and send a report as to whether the compromise has been arrived at without

any coercion or undue influence. The report of the JMIC, Patti dated 27.10.2021 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that compromise which has been effected is genuine, voluntary and without undue influence.

The FIR is outcome of misunderstanding and suspicion which has now been resolved and the matter has been compromised.

In view of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in the case of **Narinder Singh vs. State of Punjab 2014 (6) SCC 466**, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.07 dated 04.06.2018, under Sections 307, 34 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran, and all consequential proceedings are hereby quashed qua the petitioner(s).
