The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.73 dated 01.07.2020, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that intoxicant tablets containing Tramadol with a total weight of 1 kg was allegedly recovered from the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody for over a year. He is 25 year of age and he is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate which indicates that the petitioner is in custody for a period 1 year and 8 days. He, upon instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, contends that charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is 25 year of age, he is in custody for over a year, he is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is

likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
