The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 1087 dated 23.12.2016, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Karnal.

Reply, by way of the affidavit of DSP (Hq.), Karnal, is filed today in Court. In reply, with regard to role of the petitioner, it is stated that after a forged sale deed was executed in favour of co-accused Chander Kala, she executed a GPA in favour of one Anil Kumar and the petitioner was an attesting witness and later on, Anil Kumar further executed an SPA in favour of the petitioner and then the petitioner executed another sale deed dated 30.01.2018 in favour of Om Parkash Kapoor. It is, thus, submitted in the reply that incriminating evidence, showing the direct complicity of the petitioner with co-accused Chander Kala, Anil Kumar and Om Parkash Kapoor in executing fraudulent sale deeds and committing forgery and

dishonest use of forged documents, has come on record.

In view of the above, considering the serious allegations against the petitioner, this Court finds no ground to grant him the concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
