The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.78 dated 17.02.2021, under Sections 489-B and 489-C IPC, registered at Police Station Hisar City, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that fake currency notes worth Rs.3,200/- were allegedly recovered from the petitioner. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for over nine months since his arrest on 17.02.2021 and is not involved in any other case of similar nature.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ravinder Kumar, states that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined so far. She also contends that the petitioner is involved in one case under Sections 323, 148 and 149 IPC.

Heard.

In view of the above especially when the petitioner is in custody for over nine months, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is

likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
