By this petition, the petitioners seek the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR No. 16 having been registered against them at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda, on 04.02.2014, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 380, 342 and 323 of the IPC.

Though none is present for the petitioner, it being well past 04:00 p.m., however, learned State counsel, on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 02.11.2020 and presently their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, they would be given 10 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon them.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, he/she would be always at liberty to avail of his/her remedy as per law.
