Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.123 dated 13.08.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 353, 186, 506, 149 IPC (section 430 IPC added later on by virtue of DDR No.27 dated 16.08.2018).

Vide order dated 06.11.2020 passed by this Court, the ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 06.11.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.
