There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Even on the last date of hearing i.e. on 25.10.2021, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

On 25.10.2021, counsel for the State has argued that though challan was presented on 11.11.2020 but later on, the petitioner never appeared before the trial Court and even bailable warrants have been issued against the petitioner. It is further stated that under the garb of interim order, which was extended on 12.03.2020, the petitioner is not appearing before the trial Court. It was also observed that if the petitioner fail to appear before the trial Court, the interim protection shall stand vacated.

A perusal of the record show that on 17.08.2019, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail subject to the condition

that he will abide by all the provisions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and that interim order is continuing.

Counsel for the complainant on the basis of the affidavit of Kanwardeep has also opposed the prayer on the ground that the petitioner is, in fact an accused in 02 proceedings and he is not appearing in any of them.

Since the petitioner is neither appearing before this Court and nor he has complied with the order dated 17.08.2019.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
