The matter has been amicably settled between the parties. As per the statements recorded, it has been settled that respondent No.2-Insurance Company will pay a sum of Rs.8,50,000/- over and above the amount of Rs.2,75,000/- as awarded by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (for short 'the Tribunal') in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. The amount of enhanced compensation shall be paid to appellant No.2, namely, Kamlesh.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction that respondent No.2-Insurance Company shall deposit a crossed-cheque for the aforesaid amount of Rs.8,50,000/- in the name of the appellant in the office of the Lok Adalat on or before 14.09.2021, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat/Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representatives of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
