Challenge in this appeal is to the order dated 13.09.2021 passed by the learned Single Judge whereby writ petition preferred by the appellant challenging the order dated 23.04.2021 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Financial Commissioner, Haryana allowing the revision petition of the private respondents stands dismissed by upholding the said order.

Learned counsel for the appellant has sought to point out certain facts, which, according to the appellant, should have been interfered with by the Financial Commissioner, Haryana while passing the impugned order dated 23.04.2021. However, the said aspects do not, in our opinion, crave for any interference.

The only argument of the counsel for the appellant, which impresses the Court, is that this being an old matter pertaining to partition

between the co-sharers, some time bound direction may be issued to the Assistant Collector, 2nd Grade, Barwala, District Hisar-respondent No. 3 to finalize the partition proceedings within some specified time.

This prayer, as made by the learned counsel for the appellant, appears to be just and reasonable and, therefore, we accept the same.

A direction is, thus, issued to the Assistant Collector, 2nd Grade, Barwala, District Hisar-respondent No. 3 to comply with the order dated 23.04.2021 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Financial Commissioner, Haryana within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

The appeal stands disposed of in above terms.
