Prayer in this application is for placing on record reply by way of an affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Roopnagar, dated 26.10.2021, on behalf of respondents No.4 to 7.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed. Affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Roopnagar, dated 26.10.2021, is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

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In compliance with the order passed by this Court, status report by way of an affidavit dated 26.10.2021 has been submitted by the Block Development and Panchayat Officer, Sri Anandpur Sahib. In paras 5 and 6 thereof, it has been stated as follows:-

“5. That in view of the aforesaid orders, the Deputy Commissioner, Roopnagar deputed Tehsildar (Duty Magistrate), Anandpur Sahib on 14.10.2021 to remove the illegal encroachment from the clutches of Jarnail Singh s/o Baktawar Singh, Mann Singh s/o Baktawar Singh and Billu Singh s/o Jasbir Singh, all residents of village Dehni with the help of Police.

6. That the illegal encroachment has been removed by the Block Development and Panchayat Officer with the help of Tehsildar (Duty Magistrate) Anandpur Sahib and police on 15.10.2021 and the possession has been handed over to Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat, Dehni on 15.10.2021, copy of which is annesed as Annexure R-2. Hence, the orders passed on dated 14-10-2021 by the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court in Civil Writ Petition No.19663 of 2021 has been complied with.”

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Roopnagar, has also submitted his status report by way of an affidavit dated 22.10.2021, wherein also it has been stated that the illegal encroachments have been vacated and the possession handed over to the Sarpanch of petitioner – Gram Panchayat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that the toilets and bathrooms which were constructed by the Gram Panchayat, have been demolished and the same have not been restored. For the said aspect, petitioner may avail of his alternative remedy in accordance with law, if so advised.

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The writ petition stands disposed in above terms having been rendered infructuous.
