This application has been filed by respondent No.3 for disposal of the appeal.

Ms. Sharmila Sharma, Advocate, enters appearance on behalf of the non-applicant/appellant and states that she has no objection if the appeal is disposed of in terms of para 3, 4 and 5 of the application.

She has stated that the parties have settled their dispute and the Insurance Company has agreed to pay a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal. She has further stated that the appellant has given these instructions.

This application has been filed through Mr. Rajbir Singh, Advocate, who is also present in the Court through video conference. He states that the Insurance Company would pay the additional sum of Rs.1,50,000/- towards the full and final settlement of the claim over and above the amount determined by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal. Mr. Aditya Sharma, Legal Manager, ICICI Lombard General Insurance Company Limited, has filed an affidavit on behalf of respondent No.3.

In view thereof, the application is allowed and accordingly, the main appeal being FAO-254-2011 is disposed of.

The parties would remain bound by the assertions made in the application and the enhanced amount of Rs.1,50,000/- shall be paid through Account Payee cheque to the appellant within a period of one month.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the above-stated order.
