This is a petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of the order dated 01.10.2018 (Annexure P-7) passed by Special Court Judge, Tarn Taran, wherein, the petitioner has been declared as a proclaimed offender in case FIR No.30 dated 17.01.2015 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks to withdraw the present petition and further submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender within a period of three weeks from today and if he applies for regular bail after his surrender, then the same be considered as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of five days.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and the petitioner

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is directed to surrender within a period of three weeks from today and in case the petitioner applies for regular bail after his surrender, the trial Court is directed to decide the same as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of five days.
