This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to register an FIR under relevant Sections of Indian Penal Code, for the alleged offence as contained in the representation dated 27.08.2020, (Annexure P-3).

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that in respect of the alleged occurrence, a case FIR No.144 dated 17.08.2020, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, 1860 at Police Station Dhakoli, District SAS Nagar, Mohali was registered at the instance of Sukhwinder Singh, wherein the petitioner is an accused. It is also not disputed that the petitioner did not suffer any injury in the said incident. It is the case of the petitioner that two of her employees, namely, Aman and Satwinder suffered injuries, but the police did not register any case, despite the representation dated 27.08.2020. He submits that the persons, who were injured are also accused in the abovesaid FIR and remained in custody for a period of three months.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find it to be a fit case for exercising of inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C., as the alternative remedy is available with the petitioner.

Dismissed.
