The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 31 dated 03.02.2020, registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 03.11.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation. It is further submitted that in pursuance to aforesaid order, the petitioner has also deposited a sum of Rs. 2 Lakh with the Illaqua Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 03.11.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
