Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.230 dated 24.07.2021 under Sections 147, 148, 323, 325, 34 IPC and Sections 341, 506 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 Jyoti Sethi was not named in the FIR, whereas description of petitioner No.2 is given as Billa son of Nachhatar Singh, however, his name is different, therefore, his identity is disputed. It is further submitted that only offence under Section 506 IPC is non-bailable and without prejudice to their right of defence, the petitioners are ready to pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- to the victim/complainant

towards medical expenses.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Deepak Kumar Grewal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the fact that the petitioners have volunteered to pay a sum of Rs.10,000/- to the victim, without prejudice to their right of defence, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are granted the concession of anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioners will hand over the amount of Rs.10,000/- to the Investigating Officer within a period of 15 days from today and the said amount will further be handed over to victim/complainant Satpal, against a proper receipt.
