On 29.09.2021, following order was passed:-

“The basic contention of the petitioner is that after the lease was granted to the petitioner by the Gram Panchayat, there is a fish farm running in the pond of the Gram Panchayat and the adjacent areas, where ditches are there. The said fact is disputed by the counsel for the Gram Panchayat-respondent No.3.

We, therefore, call upon the Deputy Commissioner, Sri Muktsar Sahib to submit a report after getting verified the factual assertion as to whether any fish farm or fish culture or its subsidiaries are running/operating from the village pond and the other areas, which were leased out to the petitioner on 24.06.2014 for ten years.

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The said report be submitted within a period of two weeks.

In compliance of the said order, status report has been filed by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Sri Muktsar Sahib, dated 26.10.2021, wherein it has been categorically stated, on the basis of the report submitted by the Committee, which was constituted of the Tehsildar Malout, Assistant Director Fisheries Department, Sri Muktsar Sahib and Block Development and Panchayat Officer Malout, copy whereof has been appended as Annexure R-1, that only vacant village pond is present on the spot but no fish farming or fish culture or its subsidiaries are running/operating since 2017-18 from the village pond and the other areas, which were leased out to the petitioners on 24.6.2014 for 10 years.

In the light of the these categoric findings returned by the Committee, which was constituted by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Sri Muktsar Sahib, in compliance with the order passed by this Court, we do not find any ground for interference in the present petition. The writ petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
