The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned order i.e. the non-speaking order passed by the respondent on dated 10.11.2017 (Annexure P-7) and dated 28.09.2018 (Annexure P-9) on the appeal for grant of disability pension by the petitioner on 17.07.2018 (Annexure P-8) in which the petitioner has requested to respondents for grant of disability pension as he was invalided out form service in low medical category.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
