The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner in his 4th attempt seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.42 dated 06.04.2018 registered under Sections 15, 25, 61, 85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Kulgarhi, Ferozepur City.

CRM-M No.41577 of 2018 was dismissed as withdrawn on 16.10.2018. CRM-M No.26511 of 2019 along with CRM-M No.22585 of 2019 was dismissed vide order dated 28.11.2019. Thereafter, petitioner filed CRM-M No.41659 of 2019 on the ground of marriage of Kanwaljit Kaur by stating that

the petitioner is the only maternal uncle of Kanwaljit Kaur. The aforesaid fact was found to be otherwise as one more maternal uncle of Kanwaljit Kaur is also present in the house of the petitioner. The bail petition was dismissed on 09.10.2019.

Now, the petitioner seeks indulgence of this Court on the ground that due to sudden demise of his wife, there is no one to look after his children.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the prosecution evidence has already been concluded. Today is the date fixed for leading defence evidence.

Now, the Courts below are physically functioning.

No ground is made out to grant any indulgence to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
