Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.267 dated 21.09.2020 registered under Sections 409, 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

On 11.11.2020, following order was passed:-
