The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

Petitioner-Niku stated to be aged 28 years, has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with the prayer for quashing the impugned final result dated 04.03.2019 (Annexure P-5) and to decide the representation/legal notice dated 01.09.2021 (Annexure P-10) along with further relief as mentioned in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies on judgment dated 01.09.2021 (Annexure P-10) in CWP-10421-2019.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rohit Arya, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of State.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner further brings to the notice of this Court that legal notice dated 01.09.2021 (Annexure P-10)

had got served upon respondents, however, no decision has been taken by the authorities on the said notice. He further submits that in case, petitioner is awarded 4 marks of Higher Education qualification i.e. Graduation (B.Tech) including 3 years diploma in Computer Engineering, the petitioner would fall within the selection list.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3/competent authority to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as contained in the legal notice dated 01.09.2021 (Annexure P-10), in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, by passing a speaking order within **three months** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
