The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

On 28.09.2021 while issuing the notice of motion, the following order was passed:-

“The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the respondent-HSIIDC has failed to release the amount in terms of the affidavit filed in Civil Writ Petition No.6884 of 2020.

Notice of motion.

On the request of the Bench, Mr. Samarth Sagar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He prays for and is granted an adjournment to argue the matter.

List on 06.10.2021 for arguments.”

Thereafter, on 06.10.2021, the following order was passed:-

“Mr. Ankur Mittal, Advocate, enters appearance for the HSIIDC and prays for a short adjournment.

The attention of the learned counsel representing the respondent No.2 and 3 was drawn to the order, Annexure P10 at page 145 of the paper book. He assures that the necessary steps, as per the undertaking, shall be taken forthwith.

Adjourned to 26.10.2021.

No further request for an adjournment shall be entertained.”

Sh. Ankur Mittal, learned counsel representing respondent no.2 and 3 has placed on file a decision taken by the Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructural Development Corporation Limited on 25.10.2021, which reads as under:-

Sir,

With regard to the subject matter of the petition, it is submitted before Hon'ble Court that the affidavit of Chief Secretary filed before the Hon'ble Court dated 10.12.16 covers all similarly situated persons who are eligible to receive the said amount.

After due verification from M/s. Reliance as regards their employment given in terms of MoU, so far as the nine petitioners are concerned the verification so as to ascertain the eligibility is underway which will be completed within next 10 days and as per the eligibility criteria whosoever will be found eligible will be given the same benefit in further next ten days. Until now only 28 claims had come which have been decided and due payments have been made to the eligible candidates.

Matter is also being taken up with M/s. Reliance to have the record of all such cases where appointments were given by them. As regards anybody else also whosoever will be eligible and approach HSI IDC, his eligibility claim will be determined accordingly and whosoever is found eligible, payment will be released.

Sh. Ankur Mittal has assured the Court that the claim of the petitioners shall be decided within a period of next 10 days by the

HSIIDC and the payment, if any, shall be released within next 10 days.

He further submits that in future, whenever claim of the same nature as claimed in the writ petition is received, the same shall be decided expeditiously and the payment, if any, shall be made to the eligible persons within a period of 10 days.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
