Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent(s) to issue GPF numbers to the petitioners and treat them as members of the old pension scheme.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioners, on instructions, submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his clients would be satisfied in case the representation dated 10.08.2021 (P-11) is considered and decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3-Director, Food Civil Supplies Consumer Affairs Department, Punjab to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 10.08.2021 (P-11) in accordance with law by passing speaking order preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
