The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

Petitioners-Rajwinder Singh and ten others have jointly filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with the prayer for directing the respondents to release the amount of CPF contribution made by the petitioner alongwith interest and to decide the representation/legal notice dated 07.07.2021 (Annexure P-8) along with further relief as mentioned in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for same/similar grievance the petitioners had got served a legal notice upon respondents on dated 07.07.2021 (Annexure P-8), but the same has not been decided till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ayush Sarna, Asst. A.G., Punjab

accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2/competent authority to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners as contained in the legal notice dated 07.07.2021 (Annexure P-8), in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, by passing a speaking order within **five months** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case the petitioners are found entitled on merits to the claim as raised in the legal notice, the same be disbursed within **one month** from the date of decision of the legal notice.
