1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. At the outset learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the petitioner having been released benefits as per entitlement, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the Contempt Petition and the same may be disposed of as such.
3. Mr. Sandeep Moudgil, learned Addl. AG, Haryana states that non compliance was not intentional but due to administrative exigencies on account of circumstances prevailing on account of coronavirus pandemic.
4. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel and am of the view that in the peculiar circumstances, non compliance within the stipulated period of time was not intentional or wilfull, therefore, no action is required to be taken in the matter.

5. In view of the position noted above, Rule is discharged and the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not calling for any further orders.
