Learned State counsel submits that initially, the FIR was registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 IPC and the petitioner was granted the concession of anticipatory bail, however, Section 307 IPC was added later on with the allegations that rod blow, which is attributed to the petitioner on the head of victim Mufid, was, in fact, found to be a fracture on the skull.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and apply for regular bail.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 07 days from today, on a Court working day at 10.00 a.m, his regular bail application be decided on the same day.
