Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to entrust the investigation into FIR No. 66 dated 23.10.2019 under Sections 376/120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Arif Ke District Ferozepur.

It has been contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that earlier status report was filed by the Investigating Agency wherein it was mentioned that the thorough investigation was being conducted by the DSP. However, he submits that despite this nothing concrete has been done till date.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Bhavna Gupta, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. She submits that the thorough investigation has already been

conducted and the investigation which was being monitored by the higher officials now has been concluded. As per conclusion of the investigation, the cancellation report has been prepared and the same is likely to be filed before the Illaqa Magistrate within two weeks.

In view of the submissions made above, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail his remedy before the concerned Court where the cancellation would be presented in accordance with law.
