The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* quashing the para No. 3 of the letter dated 15.12.2011 (Annexure P-3), Finance circular dated 12.03.2012 (Annexure P-4), clarification dated 06.01.2015 (Annexure P-5) and Finance circular dated 05.02.2015 (Annexure P-6) with further prayer of issuing writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant pension equal to 50% of the emoluments alongwith interest @ 9% per annum, for which,

legal notice dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-8) has also been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-8) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
