The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant the benefits of revision of his pension in view of the law settled by this Court in CWP No.2866 of 2014 titled 'Karanvir Singh & others vs. State of Punjab & others' decided on 30.09.2016 and Govt. Notification dated 04.07.2019 (Annexure P2) and to pay the amount of all the aforesaid remaining benefits of the petitioner along with interest @ 18% per annum; and to decide his legal notice dated 17.06.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Kanica Sachdeva, Asst. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 17.06.2021 (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner as representation and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. If found entitled and in case there is no impediment for release of the payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
