Present petition has been filed seeking a writ of Habeas Corpus so as to get the detenue Basker Bano released from the illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 7.

For the last three dates, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Mr. J.S. Mehndiratta, Advocate, who was appointed as Amicus Curiae by this Court, has submitted that he was appointed only to assist the Court whether this Court will have jurisdiction with regard to the prayer made in the present petition or not.
