Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of interim regular bail for a period of 12 weeks in case FIR No.82 dated 25.04.2021 under Sections 379-A, 365, 120-B and 411 Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 379-A converted to Section 379-B IPC later on) registered at Police Station Samrala, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner is not keeping good health and in this regard, he has invited the attention of the Court to his medical record (Annexure P-3). He submits that the petitioner is suffering from diabetes and prays for his release on interim regular bail.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the opinion that the medical record relied upon by the petitioner is

in the nature of test reports dated 29.08.2020 and 22.03.2021, but admittedly the same was never relied upon by the petitioner, when his first petition for regular bail was dismissed on 17.08.2021.

Apparently, the petition is not founded on any new, much less a convincing ground, therefore, no case is made out for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner.
