Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to voluntarily retire the petitioner from service prematurely.

While issuing notice of motion on February 11th, 2013, following order was passed:-

“Counsel for the petitioner places reliance upon notice of motion issued by this Court in CWP No.13291 of 2012 titled as Gurjit Singh vs. State of Punjab and others, which is stated to be identical to the claim made in the present writ petition.

Notice of motion for 04.04.2013.

To be listed along with CWP No. 13291 of 2012 titled as Gurjit Singh vs. State of Punjab and others.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has apprised the Court that CWP No. 13291 of 2012 was dismissed on 17.01.2019 and the same has been affirmed in LPA No. 1208 of 2019, vide order dated January 20th, 2020.

In view of above, the learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly stated that controversy involved in the present case is squarely covered by **Gurjit Singh's (supra)**. Hence, there is no option except to dismiss the present petition in terms of the order dated 17.01.2019 affirmed in LPA No. 1208 of 2019.
